# Clan Analogue Victoria's Activities during 2014-2015

### Gear Shift electronic music jam night

Clan Analogue successfully concluded its run of *Gear Shift* jam nights. The project was funded by the City of Melbourne.

*Gear Shift* ran monthly on five occasions from July through to November, having run for five months previously during the first half of 2014. The final event for the year was held on Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> of November.

Funding from the City of Melbourne enabled *Gear Shift* to run the event at a high level of production compared to its original iteration at Horse Bazaar in 2012. This included:

- promotional budget allowing advertising on community radio and in streetpress
- live video projections provided by Object\_State
- headline electronic music performers each month, including KOshowKO, VicMod Ensemble, Ross Bencina, Sikander and Feverstone.

The event attracted audiences of up to 50 each month, with 8 to 10 participants taking part in jamming at each session.

Following the conclusion of this project the City of Melbourne encouraged Clan Analogue to reapply for funding. Nick Wilson recorded an interview with council representatives to discuss *Gear Shift* which was used by the City of Melbourne to promote their arts funding programme.

# Idiom at Forgotten Worlds

On Saturday November the 15<sup>th</sup> Clan Analogue ran the event *Idiom* to launch the album *Victris* by Sydney artist Aeriae, released on Clan Analogue Recordings.

*Idiom* had a loose "nu-IDM" theme and was held at Collingwood venue Forgotten Worlds. Aeriae and DJ Ding came down from Sydney to play at the event and were joined by local Clan Analogue-affiliated artists lubar Project and Miles Cosmo along with guest artist Denial.

The event was well-attended with the venue packed despite bad weather. The management of Forgotten Worlds invited Clan Analogue to present further events there.

# Gear Shift album launch

Following the conclusion of the *Gear Shift* jam sessions in November 2014 the collected recordings of the year-long series of jam sessions were given to Melbourne music producer and Clan member Kim Lajoie. He selected and edited the best recordings from the series to compile Clan Analogue's first live album *Gear Shift: the Best of Clan Analogue's 2014 Jam Sessions,* which was released on Clan Analogue Recordings in June 2015.

The live *Gear Shift* album was launched at Loop Bar on Wednesday the 24<sup>th</sup> of June, with a *Gear Shift* jam night at Loop which followed the format of the previous year's events.
