Clan Analogue Recordings Activities during 2010/2011

Releases

Distribution Arrangements

Clan Analogue continued to release music in physical format through MGM Distribution and in non-physical format through US aggregator The Orchard.

Four Artist EPs

Clan Analogue released four artist EPs in late 2010, attracting favourable airplay and media coverage. The four EPs were by Valley Forge, Lunar Module, Koshowko and Tiatto.

CA039V: Valley Forge – Follow Suit

The *Follow Suit* EP by Valley Forge was released in advance of the Valley Forge album *Artificial Heart*, scheduled for release in late 2011. The double-A-Side EP featured the tracks 'Follow Suit' and 'Machine-Built-Rhythm', with remixes by Single Gun Theory and Boxcar.

CA039L: Lunar Module – Lunar Module

The self-titled EP from Sydney electro-pop act Lunar Module was a 7-track minialbum, following on from tracks on Clan Analogue compilation releases.

CA039K: Koshowko – The Truth in Me

The Koshowko EP *The Truth in Me* followed on from their earlier *Promise* EP release on Clan Analogue. The EP included a reworking of the track 'Switched On', released earlier by Clan Analogue on the Winduptoys album *Double Exposure* and here remixed by Koshowko's Martin K under his new project name Philosophy of Sound. Two video clips for tracks from the EP were screened on ABC TV's 'Rage'.

CA039T: Tiatto – Theme From Tiatto

The *Theme From Tiatto* EP was the debut release for this Melbourne-based project, featuring a remix by Andy Rantzen. A video clip for the title track was screened on ABC TV's 'Rage'.

Melbourne Re Cognition launch

The Clan Analogue retrospective compilation *Re Cognition: The Clan Analogue Legacy Collection*, released in April 2010, was launched in Melbourne at the Builders Arms Hotel in Fitzroy on Saturday July the 3rd, 2010. The night included live sets from Koshowko, Winduptoys and Apell and a DJ set from DJ Zaziz.

Launch of four Clan Analogue artist EPs

On Friday, the 22nd of October, 2010, Clan Analogue held the Melbourne launch of the four new artist EPs by Valley Forge, Koshowko, Lunar Module and Tiatto. The event took place at Bar 303 in Northcote, with live sets from Valley Forge, Koshowko, Lunar Module, and Bloodloss Vegas and DJ sets from DJs Winduptoy, Sunsaria, Reductionist and Tigerlily.

Online resources

Clan Analogue has substantially increased its online presence in 2010-2011 with a focus on the development of its Facebook, Twitter, Soundcloud and Youtube pages.

The Clan Analogue Facebook group has increased its membership to more than 300 and is now the principal online discussion forum for Clan Analogue's membership and wider community.

The Clan Analogue Youtube channel now contains more than 40 videos, including the majority of filmclips from Clan Analogue releases going back to the 1990s. In

addition there are video resources such as footage from the Clan Analogue Melbourne 'Gear Shift' live jam sessions and 'Institute of Sound' electronic music workshops.

Selected tracks from the last decade of Clan Analogue releases are now available for promotional streaming via the Clan Analogue Soundcloud page. A Clan Analogue Soundcloud group has also been set up for Clan Analogue members and associated artists to upload new demos. Currently the Soundcloud group has more than 60 members.
