Releases

CA049C: Michael Mildren - Process 3: Free Electronic

Free Electronic is the third mini-album in Michael Mildren's Process series, following on from Process 1: Studies in Kraft and Process 2: Post-Kraft. The aim of this release was to utilise a more freeform improvisational style in Michael's use of vintage and contemporary analogue synths while also exploring the influence of classic 1970s "krautrock" in his music.

Free Electronic was launched at Clan Analogue's Analogue Processes event, held in September at Swamplands, Thornbury, as part of the Melbourne Fringe Festival, with live sets from Michael and from VicMod Ensemble.

Live Events

Analogue Processes - Saturday 22nd of September, 2018

Analogue Processes was held at Swamplands in Thornbury as part of the 2018 Melbourne Fringe Festival. The evening commenced with an open electronic music jam session, followed by live analogue synth sets from VicMod Ensemble and Michael Mildren. Michael was launching his new release on Clan Analogue, Process 3: Free Electronic. The event was documented for Clan Analogue's Youtube channel.

Plug In & Switch On at "Saturday Night Pre-Party Popcorn"

Northside Movies presented *Saturday Night Pre-Party Popcorn*, a series of screenings at Lupine Studios in Coburg, featuring independent community-based documentaries made by local filmmakers. Clan Analogue presented one of these sessions with a screening of *Plug In and Switch On*, the documentary about Clan Analogue's history, originally released in 2010 on the

Re Cognition: Clan Analogue Legacy Collection set. The event also featured a selection of Clan Analogue artists' filmclips and a talk by the documentary's Executive Producer Martin Koszolko.

Broadmeadows Street Festival – Sunday, 7th of April, 2019

Clan Analogue secured funding from the City of Hume for the fourth year running to present a stage at the Broadmeadows Street Festival on the 7th of April, 2018. Ming and Damian Tangram performed at the event.

Trautoniks - Thursday, 18th of April, 2019

Trautoniks was held at Bar 303 in Northcote, featuring a headline performance by Peter Pichler, on his first Australian tour from Germany. Peter is noted as the world's leading performer of the historic Trautonium, the electronic music instrument invented in the 1920s. For the performance Peter collaborated with Clan Analogue's Nick Wilson and contemporary composer Rae Howell on vibraphone. Ehsan Gelsi and Steve Williams collaborated for a support set and the event opened with a set from Michael Mildren.

Clan Analogue Online Presence

As well as expanding our reach through online platforms Facebook, Youtube, Soundcloud and Twitter, Clan Analogue has made increased use of its new Instagram page with over 225 followers. This has been used to document live Clan Analogue events as well as behind-the-scenes studio documentation.

Twitch TV channel

Clan Analogue has set up a Twitch TV channel to trial the potential for streamed live performances and other content. A test stream was run on Tuesday, 20th of November, with a performance by Nick Wilson live from Box Hill Institute. Nick's performance involved sampling live from audio material shared from the audience (both physical and online) via social media.
